

## **CORONAVIRUS/COVID-19 NOTICE**

We realize the uncertainty and fear surrounding Coronavirus, as well as the social restrictions in order to slow the spread of Coronavirus, are extremely difficult to bear, especially for those who have recently lost a loved one.

**Please, if you are sick with any illness, or have been exposed to Coronavirus, stay home and do not attend visitation or funeral services at or hosted by McNearney-Schmidt Funeral and Cremation.**

**All people who attend any gathering at McNearney-Schmidt Funeral and Cremation should practice appropriate social distancing of 6 feet between people at a gathering.**

**Please refrain from handshakes, hugging or touching at McNearney-Schmidt Funeral and Cremation.**

McNearney-Schmidt Funeral and Cremation's first priority is the health and safety of all visitors to McNearney-Schmidt Funeral and Cremation facilities and services. Governor Walz has urged Minnesotans to follow the Minnesota Department of Health guidelines regarding social distancing and public gatherings. The Governor and the Minnesota Department of Health has recommended that any gatherings over 50 people be postponed, and that gatherings with less than 50 people only be held if appropriate social distancing of six feet between people can be observed. In addition, the Minnesota Department of Health recommends that when the majority of event participants are in a high-risk group, such as the elderly, the events be limited to no more than 10 people.
